**Epilepsy:
Seizure
Smart**

Epilepsy impacts thousands of Michigan students, and 1 in 26 will be diagnosed with epilepsy at some point in their lifetime. While an epilepsy diagnosis can take place at any age, one of its most common periods of onset occurs during childhood and adolescence. School based counselors and social workers can play pivotal roles in advocating for children who experience seizures by promoting their safety, inclusion, and empowerment. This two-hour session will introduce epilepsy, including seizure recognition and first aid, as well as mental health conditions commonly associated with seizures. Join us as we learn best practices to empower the voices of students with epilepsy.
